# Tour of LDS Church History Library

Thursday, March 5th, 2015 at 6:00pm

Opened in 2009, the LDS Church History Library contains the historical records, documents, texts, manuscripts, journals, books, and other resources of the Church since The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS Church) was organized in Fayette (NY) in 1830.

The LDS Church History Library preserves, references, and provides access to members and researchers on both LDS Church History and the history of LDS families.

This will be a **special "behind the scenes" tour for the Interfaith Season**, by the Director of the LDS Church History Library, and will include areas not normally open to the public.

The tour will include the Foundations of Faith exhibit, which houses a first edition Book of Mormon, original Book of Mormon handwritten manuscript, original Book of Commandments, letter written by Joseph Smith from Liberty (MO) Jail, and more.
