2013-2014: Income – Private (45%), Gov't (17%), In-Kind (32%), Other (6%).

2013-2014: Expenses – \$533,200, with **89% going to Programs.**

- To shelter a child for 1 month is **\$530.**
- To transition 1 child to housing is **\$1,300.**

## LASTING STABILITY FOR HOMELESS FAMILIES

Family Promise - Salt Lake is a non-profit, interfaith organization that provides Shelter, Case Management and Housing services to homeless families. Since 1995, Family Promise has sheltered families and provided a supported environment for them during a very stressful time of upheaval and trauma.

We are a unique shelter in that we are comprised of a Day Center, as well as and a network of area congregations who host the families at night. This faith-community response to homelessness utilizes the many resources that congregations have to offer and provides a refuge to families in-need.

2015 is our 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Operation - Serving over 700 families, and producing over 225, 500 volunteer hours!
