Criteria for a Virtual Interfaith Season Event

1. Applicants must be affiliated with a local faith which acts in accordance with the mission statement of the Salt Lake Interfaith Roundtable.

Our mission statement is to promote love, harmony and understanding among peoples of all faith traditions, cultures, and belief systems in the spirit of the 2002 Olympic Winter Games.

2. An application form must be completed, submitted, and approved by the Interfaith Season Committee (ISC). All applications should be submitted to the ISC by **December 15th**. It is our goal to have all the events for the 2021 Interfaith Season finalized for publicity by December 31, 2020.
3. The message should be an opportunity for the Utah community to learn about your faith, your traditions, and your culture, or what your faith has in common with other faiths.
4. Possible options for a virtual event include:
 - a. ZOOM video/audio presentation online (presentation/talk/speech/lesson/musical concert).
 - b. Video tour of a faith's house of worship.
 - c. Link to a movie or video which is accessible to public (e.g. on your faith's website).
5. Political messages, candidates or political measure positions are not accepted for the Interfaith Season by the Salt Lake Interfaith Roundtable (SLIR).
6. Your faith congregation's hosting committee for your event must be willing to provide the following:
 - a. Provide an electronic flyer 8.5" x 11" (.pdf or .jpeg) to promote your event, suitable to be posted on the Salt Lake Interfaith Roundtable website at www.interfaithroundtable.org and be distributed to the SLIR mailing list and the local media.
 - b. If your faith congregation's permission is given, recordings will be made of the event which will be posted on the SLIR website during Interfaith Season, unless your event (such as a tour of a house of worship, etc.) has a link to a recording on your own faith's website. Everyone participating in your event should be aware that they may be recorded. (If a faith group approves, a video may be uploaded through the "SaltLakeInterfaithRoundtable" YouTube channel.).
7. While in most circumstances, Interfaith Season events are limited to Utah participants, the Interfaith Season Committee may approve special exceptions when there is a national or international group that promotes a major goal of the Roundtable.
